- I. Call to Order The meeting was called to order at 9:13 A.M. by Ms. LaPaglia.
- **II. Introductions** All members introduced themselves.
- III. Approval of January 10, 2020 Meeting Minutes Ms. Kopech noted that her agency name was incorrect in the minutes. Ms. Kopech motioned to approve the January 10, 2020 meeting minutes with the proposed amendment. Ms. Parks seconded; motion carried.
- **IV. Financial Report** Mr. Sheridan directed the board's attention to pages 5 16 of the packet to review the financial report. The FY2020 financial report shows no major expenditures for the year. The only expenses have been the Washington County Active Shooter Training and Ms. Parks travel to GETAC. The RAC was paying for monthly service on four iPads and now it has dropped down to one iPad and that saves about a hundred dollars a month.

The unrestricted account shows that membership dues are being submitted. The reimbursement for the BVWACS radios has not been paid by CHI St Joseph and Baylor Scott and White College Station. Ms. Kopech requested that the invoice for Baylor Scott and White be sent to her.

Supporting documents are included in the report that back up all checks and expenses. Please encourage your EMS agencies to submit requests for EMS County Allocations.

There are less than six months left in the grant year and decisions need to be made on how to spend the money. Ms. Kopech got a quote for bringing in a CEN class that would include hospitals and outlying ER facilities. It is a two day course for a flat rate of \$6,200. The charge includes travel and expenses for the speakers, registration and the course is open on an unlimited number of participants. The company also allows a registration fee if the RAC wants to charge each attendee.

Dr. Dawson motioned to approve the financial report as presented. Ms. Gaas seconded; motion carried.

V. **Executive Directors Report**

- **A.** Agency Membership Dues Dues are coming in and in process from the last few members and should be finalized in the coming month.
- B. SB 500 \$27,184 Contract Allocation Discussion This action item was tabled at the last meeting on what the support actions were going to be from this region. Ms. Kopech shared that she has been on both webcalls for the wristbands. Some key takeaways from the calls are:
 - The deadline to use the money is June 2021.
 - Arkansas uses a tracking program between EMS and hospitals.
 - The stated benefits were loop closure, feedback and billing.
 - Hospitals would have to add a place to put the tracking number in the Electronic Medical Record. There would be an initial cost and time for each facility to build the number into their management system. The EMS agency would still have to call in and give the number to get information.
 - It is voluntary to participate.
 - One idea shared was to do a pilot program in smaller RAC's to see if it is viable.

Ms. LaPaglia shared a concern that if the EMS agency and other facilities have to call in with the tracking number to get information, what is the difference with how it works now? They use patient identifying information to call in and get updates and current status. Agencies within our region already share information between each other and "play nice" without the wristbands. Ms. Parks also pointed out that there will be a recurring cost to the RAC and/or EMS Agencies to buy new wristbands each year after this initial money. Mr. Sheridan asked if there are any specifics from Arkansas on number of EMS Providers and Hospitals in the state and if their governance is different than Texas with a single or multiple source management company. Mr. Sheridan also asked about shipping and storage. Ms. Kopech said the

wristbands are 2.5 cents each from Boundtree and someone at the RAC or EMS agencies would have to store the wristbands. Several board members shared concerns that there is not enough time to execute this project, the approach is backwards and the Houston facilities and other out of region facilities that are the hardest to follow up with are the ones who do not want to participate.

Ms. Parks made a motion to table this discussion until after GETAC and review eligible expenses and requirements contained in the statement of work. Ms. Kopech seconded; motion carried.

- C. CEN Course Ms. Kopech asked board members for input on the CEN Course. Course normally costs about \$200 per nurse to go and attend a review course. Mr. Sheridan pointed out that if we did charge and got \$4,000, the RAC would have to spend \$4,000 to balance out the grant budget. Ms. LaPaglia asked how much the RAC spent to bring in Mark Boswell a few years ago. Ms. Kopech will look into the Mark Boswell course.
