- I. Call to Order The meeting was called to order at 10:00 A.M. by Mr. Sheridan.
- **II. Introductions** All members introduced themselves.
- III. Approval of February 6, 2020 Meeting Minutes –Ms. Parks motioned to approve the February 6, 2020 meeting minutes. Ms. Kopech seconded; motion carried.
- IV. Financial Report Mr. Sheridan displayed and directed the board's attention to pages 5 15 of the packet to review the financial report. There are several pending payments to Mr. Rice for travel, TETAF and Insurance that do not reflect on the report. There are no other major expenses for the current year. Today's discussion is how to spend the almost \$20,000 that is available in the budget.

One additional EMS agency has submitted a request for reimbursement under EMS County that is in process. There are 5 EMS agencies that have not submitted their request for reimbursement.

The unrestricted account shows that some BVWACS radio invoices have not been paid and there are a couple of membership dues that have not been recorded. The members will notice

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a difference in the total in the unrestricted account over the next couple of reports as sponsorships paid towards the symposium are reimbursed.

Mr. Matthews motioned to approve the financial report as presented. Ms. Gaas seconded; motion carried.

V. Executive Directors Report

- A. Budget Spending Needs There is almost \$20,000 in the budget and decisions need to be made soon on how to spend it. Ms. Parks shared that PPE is needed in Brenham. Mr. Sheridan shared that the PPE would be a 30-60 day turnaround time with the current situation. Dr. Ohaju pointed out that ventilators are in short supply for hospitals. The board discussed ventilators and who would be responsible for the maintenance on the ventilators. Mr. Rice offered to look into types and pricing for ventilators and report back to the group by the end of the day.
- B. CoronaVirus BVRAC Scope of Work Mr. Sheridan shared that the RAC has many activities and responses during COVID-19 that are becoming more and more challenging to manage. Task forces will be set up with leads to assist in each effort. The leads will identify deliverables and activities for each that can be put onto an ICS 214 form. The intent with assigning different tasks to RAC members is that they can rally others to help and get the objectives done. Mr. Deramus stated that backups are needed for all leads identified due to everyone being busy and having extra duties during this time.
 - a. Alternate Care Sites Mr. Diaz has done a lot of work in this area with identifying potential sites as well as requirements and staffing for the sites. Mr. Rice and Mr. Deramus volunteered to lead this effort.
 - b. Mass Fatality This lead will work closely with emergency managers. A key part of this will be working with hospitals to identify their capacity as well as funeral homes and other alternatives. Ms. Elmore has started this effort but needs support. Ms. Hickman volunteered to lead this effort and will have Ms. Jackson as support.
 - c. Best Practices/Lessons Learned Ms. Kopech will be working with Dr. White on identifying best practices and lessons learned during this process.
 - d. Education Packets The information coming out on a daily and sometimes hourly basis is overwhelming and often missed due to the number of emails and reports coming out. Ms. Kopech will put together education packets that summarize the key information that is coming out of state, federal and local sources. The information has to be sent to Ms. Kopech for inclusion in the packets.

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- e. Volunteers Mr. Diaz has shared that volunteers are not a concern right now but it will be in the future. The state has a website to collect medical volunteers that includes checking credentials. There is also a link on BVCOG's website to collect volunteers. The need is for one document that identifies the needs in the region and what credentials/types of volunteers are needed. Mr. Rice volunteered to assist with this effort.
- f. Donations Right now it is not a big issue and BVCOG is handling the donations coming in. Some donations are coming in that are older and someone is needed to identify what is still useable. Another need is for someone to call local offices and businesses and ask for donations. Ms. Hickman volunteered to assist with this effort and Ms. Jackson will help her.
- g. Situation Awareness Mr. Sheridan asked for input on the MWF conference calls. Mr. Deramus suggested that problems be identified on the call and solutions worked out off line and not during the call. Also need to keep the spot during the call for EMS to identify needs/situations as well as the unmet needs spot.

Mr. Sheridan displayed a statement from Dr. Jennings with Baylor Scott & White on facilities accepting potential COVID-19 positive patients and asked for input from the board. Mr. Deramus shared a concern that we do not need to create a problem while trying to fix one. At this current time there is no issues with procedures on taking patients to facilities. Recommendation is to use EM Resource and create a page or section in there. Some dispatch centers have access and know how to use EM Resource to direct crews to the appropriate facility. Others may need to get training. There is not a common terminology to indicate that a facility is not accepting COVID patients. Mr. Rice stated that hospitals need to update their information in a timely manner. Need to agree on a common terminology so everyone knows when a hospital is overcapacity. Also need to add alternate care site information into EM Resource when the time comes. Mr. Deramus suggested that facilities get together and define when they are not taking COVID patients and what terminology will be used. Ms. Kopech said that they have talked internally about what would trigger the facility to go on COVID-divert. Will work with Ms. Johse to work out what the common terminology will be.

The question was then asked if there is an in-between stop between hospital and alternate care. Would it be the MMUs? Predictions are expected on Monday and some predictions are pointing at needing 200 ICU beds. Alternate care sites could be used for more stable patients. Hospitals could be retrofitted to be full ICU. Mr. Matthews said that their agency is looking at taking stable patients to free standing facilities. Details have not been worked out but they need to be brought in to the discussions.

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VII. Open Forum – Mr. Sheridan asked the board if other meetings are needed besides the monthly meeting during this time. Mr. Deramus sees a lot of value in the small group discussions. The decision was made to hold conference calls once a week on Tuesday at 11:00. These meetings will lead to action and discussion items for the regional call on Wednesday
