- **I.** Call to Order The meeting was called to order at 9:06 A.M. by Vice Chair Kopech. Chairperson Rice participated virtually and asked Vice Chair Kopech to run the meeting.
- **II. Introductions** All members introduced themselves.
- III. Approval of May 13, 2022 Meeting Minutes Members present reviewed the minutes. Mr. Giles motioned to approve the May 13, 2022 meeting minutes. Ms. Parks seconded; motion carried.
- **IV. Financial Report** Mr. Baldree directed the board's attention to page 7 in the board packet for the roll up of the financials through April 30th. This is all processed and approved transactions for BVRAC contracts. The financials will be discussed in detail during the discussion/action item portion of the agenda.

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The unrestricted account sheet shows full detail and balances for the account.

The CHI St. Joseph EMS County request for reimbursement has been started and will be finished this month.

Mr. Giles motioned to approve the financial report as presented. Ms. Johse seconded; motion carried.

V. **Executive Directors Report –**

- A. EMS County Update EMS County update was covered in the financial report.
- B. Nominations for BVRAC Chair and Secretary According the BVRAC Bylaws, nominations are needed for BVRAC Chair and Secretary. Nominations should be submitted prior to the August General Assembly meeting for review and approval by members.
- C. **RAC Data Collaborative** The BVRAC list for the RAC Data Collaborative will be submitted to STRAC in the coming weeks. If you have not already done so, please submit names and contact information to have the ability to enter and access the data.

VI. **Discussion and/or Action Items**

A. Consider for Approval Proposed Projects – Mr. Baldree reviewed the previous discussions on proposed projects for the remaining BVRAC contract funds. These projects included laryngoscopes for Jewett EMS, HazMat equipment needs for CHI Grimes, thermometers for Bryan ISD and materials for hypertensive patients for CHI College Station. The costs for CHI Grimes may be able to be covered by the HPP committee funds this year or next year. The board decided not to cover the Bryan ISD requests since they are not a member of the RAC and there are requests from RAC members.

Mr. Richardson said that the current budget for HPP is fully expended and recommended that CHI Grimes submit a request next year. Mr. Sheridan recommended that HPP do a similar process as BVRAC in regard to projects and collect needs/requests from all interested members since more than one member may need the same items/support and it could be developed as a regional project. Mr. Richardson shared that HPP funds for the current budget were combined from all four regions to purchase Geiger counters.

Mr. Baldree displayed the following breakdown of proposed budget costs:

Mr. Sheridan recommended that the committee roll remaining funds into one or more budget lines that would cover the proposed project so there will be some flexibility in getting the funds expended by the end of the contract without further action by the board. Ms. Kopech asked if the budget adjustments affect the stroke symposium. Mr. Sheridan answered that the symposium expenses will come out of the unrestricted account.

Mr. Baldree shared that Mr. Deramus and Mr. Rice had submitted emails regarding the Pinnacle conference and reimbursements that may be available for expenses. Ms. Kopech brought up the idea that people who are sent to conferences with RAC funds should come back to the RAC and share the information that was learned.

Ms, Parks made a motion to approve the proposed projects listed. Mr. Giles

- B. Consider for Approval Discuss Budget Adjustment Ms. Parks made a motion to approve the budget adjustments that are necessary by the end of August to expend grant funds. Mr. Giles seconded; motion carried.
- C. **Discuss Options for FTEP Course** Participants from BVRAC member agencies can attend the training for free but participants from outside BVRAC will be charged tuition. The course will be August 16-18, 2022. Mr. Baldree shared that the class will be set up on Eventbrite and there can be a promo code for RAC members so they are not charged tuition, but their participation can be noted. Mr. Sheridan asked how many seats will be allocated to the RAC and outside agencies. Mr. Deramus suggested 20 seats open for RAC members and 15 seats open for paying attendees. Ms. Kopech suggested seeing how many agencies want to participate and divide up the available seats among those agencies. If the agency wants to send more people, they can pay for the additional seats. Mr. Sheridan suggested that if the training is comprised of mostly RAC members that any

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remaining funds for EMS RAC be used for the training to allow unrestricted funds to be utilized elsewhere.

Ms. Parks asked when education items should be discussed for next year. Mr. Sheridan suggested that the board develop a budget at the next meeting and adjust when contracts are received.

VII. Committee Significant Items

Stop the Bleed training was provided to 162 Anderson Shiro ISD middle school and high school students with help from local law enforcement in May. Mr. Sheridan provided a stop the bleed course in May with 12 participants with the state guard.

Ms. Terrell shared that CHI will be transitioning to Tenecteplase for Stroke patients.

VIII. Open Forum

Ms. Johse shared that the tents for CHI College Station and CHI Regional are in bad shape. Mr. Richardson reminded everyone that the available budget in HPP for BVRAC is usually around \$5,000 each year.

Mr. Sheridan recommended that General Assembly consider authorizing Mr. Baldree to spend the remaining balance of the funds on minor projects that would benefit the RAC. This would ensure funds are expended by the end of the grant year.

Ms. Kopech gave an update from the GETAC meeting:

- Funds will be reduced next year. Expecting a 20-50% loss.
- Discussion on keeping the rural trauma centers up and going.
- State representative will attend August meeting with more exact numbers
- Discussed the stroke rules and proposed maternal rules. Also discussed trauma rules that are projected to go live in September 2023. There are a lot of rules in there that will impact all trauma centers
- Senate Bill 8 They are looking at pushing funds out to the RACs to bring in more paramedics and EMTs
- Want Pulsara to go in state-wide and are looking at updating the rules. Showed how the wristband project ties into Pulsara. Facilities that are not utilizing wristbands will have to answer to that decision.

Ms. Kopech received a request to host the Rural Trauma Course on December 9th with the RAC. CHI will do the advertising but asked if BVRAC could provide the facility and provide lunch.

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FCCS course is going on next week. Please make sure those from your facility that are signed up to attend do attend since RAC funds were used for this course.
