- I. Call to Order The meeting was called to order at 10:05 A.M. by Ms. Lugar
- **II. Introductions** No introductions were required.
- III. Approval of the June 7, 2018 Meeting Minutes Dr. Ohaju motioned to approve the June 7, 2018 meeting minutes. Mr. Matthews second; motion carried.
- **IV. Financial Report** Mr. Sheridan provided the financial report highlights as represented on pages 4-16 of the BVRAC Board of Directors packet. The Expenditure Report, pg. 4, lists the breakdown of costs associated with state received revenue. Mr. Sheridan displayed the full budget allocation in order to present total remaining funds and present future expenditures.

The largest expenditure made was for \$19,558.03 dedicated to ZOLL Rescue Pumps. Additional pending expenditures include Washington County EMS reimbursement for rescue pumps, purchase of two stop the bleed training kits, and \$600 remaining in the GETAC

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travel category. The remaining expenditure will exceed the initial budget projections. Mr. Sheridan stated that any expenditures over remaining funds would be taken out of management fees to cover those costs and zero the balance.

The Unrestricted Funds report had little change from the previous month. The Stroke Symposium completed its last check request and that will be reported in next month's report after it posts in finance.

The Check/Voucher Register lists all expenditures for BVRAC to ensure multiple means to balance the funding. The remaining reports are supporting documents listing expenditures and costs for each category.

Dr. Ohaju motioned to approve the financial report. Ms. Ponzio second; motioned carried.

# V. Executive Directors Report

- **A. July Reports** FY 18 Reports have been completed and submitted to the state. FY19 reports will be due no later than July 20, 2018. These reports include two anticipated expenditure reports, Narrative Objectives, and the EMS County Distribution Plan which are the deliverables for contract HHS000124600006.
- **B.** EMS County Report Only one EMS provider has not submitted for reimbursement. Reimbursements were due in June 1, 2018 to allow time to process and submit to the state. That will provider will be sent an additional reminder.
- C. Nominations The Board of Directors reviewed current officer and committee chair nominations for the August 2, 2018 BVRAC elections. All positions have at least one nomination. A message will be sent to General Assembly reminding members to submit their nominations by 1500 July 19, 2018.
- **D.** Trauma Systems Plan The Board was reminded to update the Trauma Systems Plan soon so that it can be reviewed and approved at the next General Assembly meeting.

### VI. Discussion/Action Items

A. Consider for approval the outline goals for the upcoming year to enhance and improve delivery of EMS and Trauma Patient Care –

Mr. Matthews motioned to approve the outline goals for the upcoming year to enhance and improve delivery of EMS and Trauma Patient Care as discussed. Ms. Jennings seconded the motion; the motion carried.

B. Consider for approval the purchase of the Stop the Bleed trainer kits -

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Ms. Jennings motioned to approve the purchase of two Stop the Bleed trainer kits as presented. Ms. Johse seconded the motion; the motion carried.

C. Consider for approval the reimbursement to Washington County EMS for three ZOLL Rescue Pump kits -

Ms. Jennings motioned to approve reimbursing Washington County EMS \$3,000 for three ZOLL Rescue Pump kits. Mr. Matthews seconded the motion; motion carried.

# VII. Committee Reports

- **A.** Education Ms. Sheridan presented a message on behalf of Ms. Parks. Ms. Parks wanted to emphasis continuing with the NRP skills check off course, the planning for the Stroke/Cardiac Symposium, and discuss bringing a Stroke Certification Review Course to the region. The cost for the two day Stroke Certification Review course would be around \$1,200.
- **B.** Pre-Hospital Mr. Sheridan announce that all the ZOLL Rescue Pumps have been purchased and are sitting in the office for pick up. There are three rescue pumps not allocated to an agency or organization. The board discussed the allocation will go to the hospitals. The allocation will be determined at the next General Assembly meeting.
  - ZOLL provided an instructor to the region during July 9-19, 2018. Twelve medics attended the one hour training.
- C. Hospital Care and Management/Acute Care Ms. LaPaglia informed Board members that the Pre-hospital sepsis activation criteria check list has been forwarded for review and comment. One of the next steps is to identify which data to collect.
- **D.** Stroke Ms. Hickman announced that the BVRAC Stroke diagram is very outdated and will require significant modifications. Ms. Hickman will adjust the diagram and submit to the General Assembly for review and comment. The goal would be to get the Physicians Advisory to review and approve before bringing it before General Assembly for final approval.
  - Ms. Hickman also open for deliberation next year's Stroke Symposium venue and training opportunities. The goal would be to hold a two day symposium with other venues and perhaps charging a small fee for attending. The symposium planning will start in about three months.
- **E.** System QI/Physician's Advisory No further updates.

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- **F.** Injury Prevention Ms. Johse announced that the training team has completed two more classes and the next one is scheduled August 17, 2018 for the city of Anderson teachers. BVRAC target goal is to teach to at least 3,000 people however there is a limited means to collect the information from a single source. There are other groups teaching the class and that information needs in a collaborated effort.
- **G.** Disaster/Emergency Preparedness No further updates
- **H.** Perinatal No Report

# VIII. Open Forum

- **A.** Ms. Lugar addressed the question on whether or not a separate mental health questionnaire form should be developed or just added to the current SQI form now being used. After deliberation, members decided to add to the SQI form.
- **B.** Ms. Lugar asked the best means to get Hospital POC information. Mr. Sheridan said he would provide her the member's list information for the RAC.
- IX. Dr. Ohaju recommended offering the Rural Trauma Team Development Course (RTTDC). There is no cost except payment for books. CE is offered through the American College of Surgeons. All trauma team members would benefit from this course including EMS and hospital personnel.
- X. Important Dates BVRAC General Assembly is August 2, 2018.
