- I. Call to Order The meeting was called to order at 9:03 A.M. by Mr. Rice
- **II. Introductions** All members introduced themselves.
- III. Approval of March 8, 2019 Meeting Minutes Ms. Parks motioned to approve the March 8, 2019 meeting minutes. Ms. Johse seconded; motion carried.
- **IV. Financial Report** Ms. Parks presented the financial reports as referenced in the Board of Directors packet on pages 9 24. The only new expenses that are on the report are Ms. Parks reimbursement of expenses to attend GETAC, purchase of eighty-five Stop the Bleed kits, insurance, and an EMS County reimbursement for Texas A&M EMS. worked on during the May meeting for the next year. Supporting documents for all expenses are included in the report.

Ms. Parks shared that she got a quote for El Paso RAC to come and do the CEs and CMEs for the symposium next year. They charge \$2,000 for the CMEs, \$200 or \$250 per 50 for nurses and EMS participants, and travel expenses for the person to come administer it. The Board will need to start discussions on this once the current symposium is finished. Ms. Parks figured that the total would be close to \$4,000.

Mr. Matthews motioned to approve the financial report as presented. Ms. LaPaglia seconded; motion carried.

V. Executive Directors Report

- A. Report Updates 2nd & 3rd Financial Report and B13 Submitted Ms. Hill reported that all reports have been submitted as required.
- **B. RAC Contracts** Ms. Hill updated the members on the new contracts that have been received. Contract covers two years and starts on May 1 2018 August 31, 2020. Funding amounts are pretty level with a slight decrease overall. The RAC System Development portion for this year is included in the contract but has not been approved yet.

VII. Open Forum

- **A.** Ms. LaPaglia asked if anyone wanted to volunteer some time to review the Trauma System Plan. Mr. Matthews recommended that the plan be sent out by email or uploaded from the website and if it is determined that a meeting is needed to review, it will be scheduled later.
- **B.** Mr. Matthews shared that Bryan Fire Department had their CAST site review last week and found no deficiencies. They have been recommended to the board and should be CAST certified on the 29th. Bryan Fire Department is the second fire-based EMS agency to receive the certification in Texas. Plano is the only other fire-based agency.
- C. Mr. Rice asked if anyone had a good medical simulation mannequin. Mr. Ruemke said Washington County EMS has one but it is probably not what he is needed. Blinn and A&M have them but they cannot leave the facility. There are two big things coming up in May for the region. The Regional SIM competition will be 3 days for teams of two on May 20-22. A multi-disciplinary judges team will be put
