- **I.** Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 1:30 P.M. by Mr. Sheridan.
- **II. Introductions:** General Assembly conducted self-introductions.
- **III. Approval of August 6, 2020 Minutes:** Ms. Brooks motioned to approve the August 6, 2020 minutes with the change. Ms. Parks seconded; motion carried.
- IV. Presentation SANE Nurse Program Baylor Scott & White College Station Ms. Laney shared that the SANE Nurse Program is made up of specially trained nurses that

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work with victims of sexual assault and abuse along with Law Enforcement and may have to testify in court. This is the only SANE Nurse Program in the region and there is a nurse on call 24/7. Their focus is on the health of the patient first and if they can collect evidence in the process, they do. Sexual assault is a traumatizing event but having to tell their story multiple times and face multiple exams is also traumatizing. Partners in the region can send a stabilized sexual assault patient to them. They ask that you do not perform an exam, talk about history or spent time testing or medicating. The patient and family need to be prepped for the exam. One member asked if the numbers have increased or decreased due to COVID and Ms. Laney shared that numbers were low when everyone was afraid to come in but numbers are back to normal for now. V. Financial Report: Mr. Sheridan directed the board's attention to pages 5 - 15 of the packet to review the financial report. BVRAC achieved a zero balance on all contracts for the last fiscal year.

There is an agenda item to amend the Systems Development budget to make purchases to support the COVID-19 response in the region.

Five EMS County providers have fully completed their requests and two are in process. One provider needs to start the process. After the EMS County I funds have been finalized, the EMS County II funds will be opened. Requests must be submitted by June 1st for EMS County II funds.

The budget shows \$7,000 is allocated to the BVWACS radio invoice. This morning the BVRAC Board of Directors approved increasing the budget to \$9,500 to cover the additional radios added to the system.

Ms. Johse motioned to approve the financial report as presented. Ms. Brooks seconded; motion carried.

VI. Executive Directors Report

- A. EMS County Update Information covered in the Financial Report
- **B.** Membership Dues Dues are due by December 31st. Dues can be paid by check or online. Mr. Sheridan went through the www.bvcog.org website to show participants how to pay dues using the website.
- **C. Representation Forms** Please submit representation forms through the Google links provided to ensure the right people are voting and getting information.
- **D. SB 500 New Project Discussion** There is a \$13,478 left in the SB500 contract. The board's recommendation on how to use the money will be covered in the committee budget discussion and action item later in this meeting.
- **E. BVRAC Senior Christmas Sponsorship** BVCOG coordinates the collection, assembly and delivery of gifts to seniors in over twenty area nursing homes. There are a lot of staff that take care of the seniors in these facilities that have

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experienced increased stress and work during this time. BVRAC Board voted to provide \$1,000 towards gifts for the personnel that work at nursing homes. If there is any organization that would like to help with Senior Christmas efforts, please let Mr. Sheridan know.

F. Committee Budget Discussion – The recommendation from the BVCOG Board is to purchase three additional decon units, with SB 500 and RAC System Development funds. The remaining funds will be allocated to a small Stop the Bleed training kit for Scott & White Brenham and \$10,000 towards Education.

VII. Discussion and/or Action Items

Consider for approval budget amendment for purchase of AeroClave RDS3110 Decon Units to support regional response efforts – Mr. Matthews made a motion to accept the budget amendment to purchase three AeroClave RDS3110 Decon Units to support regional response efforts. Ms. Gaas seconded; motion carried.

VIII. Committee Reports

- A. Disaster/Emergency Preparedness Committee (Cory Matthews): Mr. Matthews shared that there is discussion in committee on new rules for Hospital and EMS Agencies. Agencies will be hit with financial penalties for noncompliance. There is funding available for COVID-related activities and response. Projects can be presented in December.
- **B. Education (Ashley Kopech):** Ms. Kopech shared that facilities/agencies will do an educational presentation or case study with the following schedule during General Assembly meetings:
 - 1. December CapRock
 - 2. February CHI Bryan
 - 3. April CHI EMS
 - 4. June CHI College Station
 - 5. August Washington County EMS

Ms. Kopech will continue looking at educational needs and opportunities for the region.

- C. Pre-Hospital (Bryan Ruemke for Kevin Deramus): No report
- **D.** Hospital Care and Management/ Acute Care (Debbie Burkhardt): Ms. Burkhardt shared that normally they would be preparing for the symposium. She asked if the group wanted to put together a virtual symposium. Ms. Burkhard needs input from the group and assistance in getting everything set up.
- **E.** Stroke (Amy Jackson for Rebecca Hickman): Ms. Hickman informed the group that the Stroke Association is doing a stroke symposium on Friday November 6th. The registration fee is \$20.
- **F.** System QI/Physician's Advisory (Dr. Ohaju/Wanda Diaz): Ms. Diaz shared that transfer numbers are being shared and if anyone has any Systems QI issues that need to be reviewed by Dr. Ohaju, to please send them in.

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- **G. Injury Prevention** (**Ashley Johse**): Ms. Johse shared that College Station ISD has approached them about doing stop the bleed training for the middle schools.
- **H. Perinatal (Dr. Dawson):** Dr. Dawson shared that there are no special items to report except to encourage people to sign up for the training on November 13th on Pregnancy Related Emergencies: What to Ask and What to Do.
- **IX. Open Forum** Mr. Sheridan shared that the goal is to open BVCOG. The next meetings are planned to be in person.
