- I. Call to Order The meeting was called to order at 10:00 A.M. by Chairman Rice.
- **II. Introductions** All members introduced themselves.
- III. Approval of December 2, 2021 Meeting Minutes Members present reviewed the minutes. Mr. Ruemke noted a missing period and an incomplete sentence that needed to be corrected in the minutes. Mr. Ruemke motioned to approve the December 2, 2021 meeting minutes with corrections noted. Ms. Kopech seconded; motion carried.
- **IV. Financial Report** Ms. Spittler directed the board's attention to page 5 in the board packet where there is a roll up of the financials through November 30th. RAC Systems Development

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has \$47,296.07 remaining and EMS RAC has \$29,546.04 remaining in the budget. EMS County requests have not hit the system yet and LPG funds have been spent. Unrestricted has the same amount as last month. Pages 8-11 in the packet are the pages that show specific areas were the funds went. On page 14 you can see the bulk of the change to the financial report with the addition of dues paid by member agencies

Two check requests are being processed today that will be included in next month's report. Mr. Giles motioned to approve the financial report as presented. Ms. Parks seconded; motion carried.

V. Executive Directors Report

- **A. BVRAC Agency Dues and Representation Forms** –There are many agencies that have not paid their dues or submitted the representation form. Ms. Hill has sent out a notice to the agencies with missing dues or forms. This needs to be closed out as quickly as possible. These forms build the contact lists for BVRAC meetings and training information. Please submit forms and dues as soon as possible.
- **B.** EMS County Update Two EMS agencies have submitted reimbursement requests and are in process. The remaining agencies need to submit their requests soon.

C. RAC Chairs Committee Meeting Brief –

Texas RAC Data Collaborative - The Texas RAC Data Collaborative is \$2,850 for the first year and may be less for following years. The hold up on this moving forward is the concern about the holding of the data and what safeguards are in place. There will be a separate governance structure, and everyone will have opportunity to have a representative. The large systems will have a legal hurdle to go through to participate but it will provide a lot of data that everyone can use. This would be a great investment for the RAC. Ms. Kopech and Ms. Parks will set up a presentation from the state with RAC agency IT and administrators to discuss the collaborative and concerns.

Regional Workforce Recruitment - Senate Bill 8 allocated \$21.7 million for EMS workforce recruitment. The state is brainstorming different ways to use this money which may include dividing the money between the RACs. Discussions will be ongoing on these funds. Mr. Sheridan shared with the Board that the Workforce Board has programs to get training to individuals, but they are not getting a lot of interest. Whoever takes the lead with this should coordinate with Mr. Sheridan/BVCOG to take advantage of the promotion and programs available in BVCOG. Mr. Deramus shared that one of the options being discussed included sending money directly to the RACs to reimburse sending people to training.

<u>Wristband Projects-</u> Wristband project was thoroughly discussed. The hope is that one of the other RACs will iron out all the issues and figure out how to implement

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through IT and the other necessary steps. Most RACs, including HOTRAC, are putting the wristbands on and entering the number but are not tracking or doing anything with it. The federal or state government will probably have to mandate this for some of the bigger health systems to participate.

D. RAC Website Review – Mr. Sheridan reviewed the BVRAC website (www.bvrac.org) with board members present. Board members were encouraged to submit pictures of events and new members should submit headshot photographs for inclusion on the website. Mr. Rice asked for fillable documents in the Resources Section. Events and trainings can be added to the website. Please send any information for or additions to the website to Ms. Hill.

E. Additional Items from Executive Director

- 1. BVWACS Radios BVCOG reviewed the Washington County BVWACS radio invoice and noted that the invoice was short by 4 radios. Washington County was made aware of this and submitted an invoice for these four radios which has been reviewed and payment is being processed. These radios include three radios for PHI that fall under CHI EMS and one radio for Encompass Health.
- 2. COVID What are the current projections, shortfalls, and needs? Ms. Kopech shared that Scott and White is at capacity which is not new. With 20-30% of the workforce out, they are not able to provide the level of care that they would expect. This is probably going to be the status for the next couple of weeks and may be our new normal. Ms. Parks shared that the main problem in the ER is the public coming into the ER for a COVID test. Many testing options for the public are not available or are greatly reduced. The quick tests are useful to test your workforce but often are not accepted by agency human resource departments for workers trying to come back to work. Local businesses and restaurants are experiencing an impact in workers being sick or exposed and unable to work. The message that should be shared with public officials is to not go to the emergency room unless it really is an emergency.
- 3. EMResources Need to revisit and get it updated with some of the functionalities updated. Ms. Kopech will get together with Doug and get the items added that would be useful. When a hospital goes bad, it happens very quickly and EMResources could help get the word out quickly if it was structured correctly. This will be a General Assembly discussion.
- **4.** MMUs Mr. Giles found damage to the MMU/trailer and has reached out to CATRAC regarding insurance. Washington County will put up their MMU as a training for the CERT team and will check on status of trailer and tent. HCC does have some funds available to the region so if there are repairs or things that need to be replaced, please let BVCOG know

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VII. Committee Reports

- **A.** <u>Disaster/Emergency Preparedness Committee</u> (Bryan Ruemke) TAMU said that this year is not the year to participate in Disaster Day. Mr. Ruemke has committed to take the Washington County MMU to the event. The Brazos Valley Search and Rescue Exercise is planned for January 29th. There is a meeting next week to decide if the event will be moving forward.
- **B.** Education (Jason Giles/Ashley Kopech) The FCCS course was cancelled due to inpatient COVID numbers. The books for the course have already been sent out. BVRAC needs to decide if the books will be purchased or advanced to the June course. The board would like to advance to the June course.

There will be an ACLS Renewal Course on February 11th. It will be held at BVCOG. There are a few seats still remining.

- Mr. Sheridan shared that a request has been submitted for EMS Conference that did not go through the proper channels for approval with Education. Mr. Giles agreed that the request can be approved and processed.
- C. <u>Pre-Hospital</u> (Kevin Deramus) Mr. Rice commented that Jewett and Robertson County EMS have shared that they need McGrath Laryngoscopes. Quotes will be acquired and this will be added to an agenda for review and discussion at a future meeting.
- **D.** Hospital Care and Management/ Acute Care (Lacey Krchnak) No report
- E. Stroke (Paula Terrell) Continued help is needed with organizing the symposium. Ms. Terrell put together all of the files from Ms. Hickman in a google drive that she will send out to anyone wanting to help to aid with coordination. Ms. Kopech has notes on who was asked to speak for each session for the symposium that was cancelled. She will type up the information in an email and send to everyone. Ms. Parks reminded everyone that CEs are a critical part of the event and she will reach out to the contact from last time.
