I. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 1:00 P.M. by Ms. Parks. Ms. Parks is standing in as Chair of the meeting due to Chairman Rice not being able to attend.

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October 7, 2021 1:00 P.M.
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- **II. Introductions:** General Assembly conducted self-introductions.
- III. Approval of August 5, 2021 Minutes: Members present reviewed the minutes from August 5th. Mr. Turek motioned to approve the August 5, 2021 minutes with the correction. Ms. Fritz seconded; motion carried.
- **IV. Financial Report:** Ms. Spittler directed the member's attention to pages 6 18 of the packet to review the financial report. The financials are through August 31st. The funds have been expended for FY2021. No funds have been expended for FY2022. The contract amounts are \$49,847 for RAC Systems Development, \$35,291 for EMS RAC, \$83,841 for EMS County, \$11,282 for LPG and \$20,000 for Unrestricted for a total of \$200,261 that needs to be spent.

Mr. Turek motioned to approve the financial report as presented. Mr. Ferrell seconded; motion carried.

V. Presentation — Ms. Kopech and Ms. Parks shared information on the National Pediatric Readiness Project that will be implemented through the rules process. The readiness project is a multiphase quality improvement initiative that includes essential guidelines and resources to improve the quality of emergency care of children. The rules changes will make the readiness survey mandatory for hospitals.

VI. Executive Directors Report

- A. Update on Purchases All funds from the last physical year have been spent.
- **B.** Meetings RAC meetings will be moved to Zoom because BVCOG GoTo meeting contract is expiring and it is not being renewed.
- C. Mr. Kazmir shared that he is moving on to a new position at A&M and today is his last meeting.

VII. Discussion and/or Action Items

- A. Consider for approval authorizing signature authority to Roger Sheridan as the BVRAC Administrator Ms. Parks made a motion to approve authorizing signature authority to Roger Sheridan as BVRAC Administrator. Mr. Turek seconded; motion carried.
- B. Consider for approval new formula for determining EMS Agency Dues Mr. Rice shared that the recommendation on the table is \$50 / licensed ambulances. Mr. Deramus made a motion to change the EMS Agency Dues to \$50/licensed ambulance. Mr. Turek seconded; motion carried. Mr. Gallagher shared that his dues are already pre-budgeted. The funds will not break them, but it is not in the budget. Mr. Gallagher made a motion to accept the \$50/licensed ambulance starting in FY2023. Mr. Turek seconded; motion carried.

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- C. Consider for approval expending remaining funds on Travel and Training Expenses to close out the contract year Ms. Johse made a motion to approve expending remaining funds on Travel and Training Expenses to close out the contract year. Ms. Kopech seconded; motion carried.
- D. Consider for approval the appointment of a new BVRAC Hospital & Acute Care Committee Chair to complete the remaining term to August 31, 2022 Ms. Kopech made a motion to appoint Ms. Krchnak from Grimes CHI as the new BVRAC Hospital & Acute Care Committee Chair. Ms. Parks seconded; motion carried.

VIII. Committee Reports

- **A.** Disaster/Emergency Preparedness (Cory Matthews): There is discussion about doing a radiation exercise in FY22. The committee is looking at ways agencies in this area can participate remotely. Also, would be possible to do an exercise on the reactors at A&M or the different trucks moving through the region.
- **B.** Education (Jason Giles): There was a stop the bleed class held in Navasota at one of the elementary campuses. An ACLS course will be held at BVCOG on October 29th.
- C. Pre-Hospital (Kevin Deramus): The committee wants to keep the current objectives to conduct a needs assessment and provide a regional EMS Capability Brief and add a lessons learned from COVID-19 and Leadership and Professional Development Course. The group is historically bad about collecting information and needs assessment need ideas and suggestions on how to collect the information and data from all agencies. Suggestion was made for each service to put together the needs for that agency.
- **D.** Hospital Care and Management/ Acute Care (Vacant): Ms. Parks shared that the group met at lunch and discussed having the Stroke Symposium in September and it being a two-day event.
- **E. Stroke (Paula Terrell):** Revisions have been made on the Stroke Service Plan and it will be sent out next week for review. Please pay attention to the transfer section of it and the group will need to talk it through to make sure it works.
- **F.** System QI/Physician's Advisory (Dr. Ohaju): Ms. Parks has been the only one who has sent any cases for review. Please continue to send in any cases that may be for review. Dr. Ohaju discussed several cases that were transferred out of our region that could have been taken care of in our system. The group also needs more information with some cases submitted.
- **G. Injury Prevention (Ashley Johse):** Continues partnering with Education committee for courses. There is a stop the bleed course scheduled for Encompass Health and a Home School group has approached the committee about getting training.
