I. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 12:00 P.M. by Chairman Rice.

Brazos Valley Regional Advisory Council General Assembly Meeting – GoTo Meeting Webinar Call

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- **II. Introductions:** General Assembly conducted self-introductions.
- III. Approval of October 7, 2021 Minutes: Members present reviewed the minutes from October 7th. Mr. Gallagher motioned to approve the October 7, 2021 minutes. Mr. Ferrell seconded; motion carried.
- IV. Financial Report: Ms. Spittler directed the member's attention to pages 6 15 of the meeting packet to review the financial report. A correction to the top of page 6 was noted where the dates should be 01SEP21 to 31AUG22. The financials show the contracts and associated funds available. RAC Systems Development has \$49,847 allocated to it and \$387.07 has been spent. EMS RAC has \$35,291 allocated to it and \$6,075.74 has been spent. EMS County has \$83,841 and no expenses have hit the system yet, but one request has been submitted. All funds allocated to EMS LPG have been spent. Unrestricted has \$20,000 allocated and \$9,136.38 has been spent. The pages following the charts show the expenses broken down by each contract and checks paid and revenue for each.

Ms. Kopech motioned to approve the financial report as presented. Mr. Lamb seconded; motion carried.

- V. Educational Presentation Mr. Giles provided an education presentation on the Vial of Life program. This program started in California in the late 1980's. It is a standardized form that collects medical, prescriptions and other important information and is kept in the individual's home as a reference for first responders that come into the home. It is especially useful when the individual is unable to communicate with the first responders. Bryan Fire has developed their own form with their logo and the suggestion is for agencies to put their own logo or for a form to be developed with the BVRAC logo. To identify households that participate a sticker is placed on the fridge or front door. Some ideas brought up during the presentation include:
 - **A.** Send the completed form/information home with patients that are leaving the hospital along with a magnet for the fridge or a sticker. That way the information is already filled out and not forgotten about by the patient.
 - **B.** Keep the forms on ambulances to distribute as responders come in contact with individuals who may benefit from the program.
 - **C.** Mr. Lamb is talking with nursing homes, assisted and independent living facilities in Bryan. He plans on attending the resident meetings at the independent living facilities to give a presentation and hand out forms to those who would like to participate.

The benefit of the form is replacing the large book of information that is often handed to pre-hospital folks when helping a patient and prevent the loading of medications into a bag to take with them when the medications and doses are already listed on the form.

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Mr. Giles suggests using available funds to implement this program across the region. A workgroup will be set up to discuss steps to implement and what needs to be purchased and developed.

If an agency does not attend at least 4 of the 6 General Assembly meetings, they are not eligible to vote. Please let Ms. Hill know if there are errors. The final attendance will be provided at the next General Assembly

B. Community Health Assessment – Mr. Burdine's team is unable to attend today's meeting and may reschedule the assessment for a later meeting.

VII. Discussion and/or Action Items

- **A.** Consider for approval FY2022 EMS County Distribution Plan Mr. Ferrell made a motion to approve the FY2022 EMS County Distribution Plan. Mr. Leland seconded; motion carried.
- **B.** Consider for approval MMU Support for TAMU Disaster Day The BVRAC Board discussed providing support and the board agreed to support with the condition that BVRAC is invited to participate. A motion by General Assembly is not needed. Mr. Ruemke has volunteered Washington County's tent and CHI can provide theirs as well. TAMU Disaster Day contacts will have to fill out a form to use the tents.
- C. Mr. Ruemke was appointed chair of the Disaster Committee since Mr. Matthews has decided to step down. Mr. Giles made the motion to accept Mr. Ruemke's appointment as Disaster Chair. Ms. Johse seconded; motion carried.

A. Disaster/Emergency Preparedness (Bryan Ruemke/Cory Matthews): The BVSAR Annual Exercise is on January 29th. Anyone interested can come out to participate, just let Mr. Matthews know.

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There is \$2,600 available to BVRAC agencies and projects through the Healthcare Coalition Committee (HCC). Develop some ideas for projects and bring them to the next HCC Meeting

B. Education (Jason Giles/Ashley Kopech): BVRAC paid for four attendees to attend the FCCS course at CHI Regional last year. This year, the Education Committee proposes paying for six people to attend the course on January 22nd and 23rd. Spots will be first come first served but the chair will spread the opportunity to as many agencies as possible. A flyer will be distributed to the RAC. Those interested in attending should contact Mr. Giles or Ms. Kopech.

Scott & White College Station will do a presentation or case study at the next General Assembly meeting

There will be an ACLS Update Course offered on February 11th at BVCOG. Participants must have an active ACLS card to attend. Time will be from 9:00 am – 1:00 pm. If someone reserves a spot in the training and is a no show, they may be charged a \$25 fee that will be added to BVRAC funds.

- C. Pre-Hospital (Kevin Deramus): No report.
- D. Hospital Care and Management/ Acute Care (Lacey Krchnak): No report
- **E. Stroke** (**Paula Terrell**): September 7th and 8th have been secured for the Acute Care/Stroke Symposium at the Brazos County Expo Center.

The state has noted that a metrics on ROSC patients is not being tracked/met in the region. Staff at the ER will be asking EMS Personnel some additional questions on any ROSC patients brought in to include ROSC time, setting, initial rhythm and time from collapse to CPR given. There needs to be a big education push to EMS personnel on this.

- **F.** System QI/Physician's Advisory (Dr. Ohaju/Wanda Diaz): Ms. Diaz provided an autopsy follow up on a previous case discussed in February 2020 as well as updated statistics on transfers and a case discussion.
- **G. Injury Prevention (Ashley Johse):** Stop the Bleed courses were provided to Encompass Health and AirMed Staff as well as a neighborhood group. Stop the Bleed training was provided to 9,105 people in 2021. The majority was for College Station ISD students (4,250 at the high schools, 2,200 at the middle

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schools and 2,100 at the intermediate schools) as well as staff that watched the video produced by Ms. Johse and Ms. Kopech.
