- I. Call to Order The meeting was called to order at 10:00 A.M. by Chairman Rice.
- **II. Introductions** All members introduced themselves.
- III. Approval of October 6, 2022 Meeting Minutes Members present reviewed the minutes. Mr. Ruemke motioned to approve the October 6, 2022 meeting minutes. Mr. Deramus seconded; motion carried.
- **IV. Financial Report** Mr. Baldree directed the board's attention to page 6 in the board packet for the roll up of the financials through September 30<sup>th</sup>. The main charges so far have been

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administrative and the symposium. The last two training tourniquets identified with the needs assessment were received this week.

The BVWACS bill was paid from the unrestricted account and invoices have been sent out to agencies for reimbursement. The final expenses for the symposium were also paid out of the unrestricted account including gift cards for speakers and food for the symposium. The budget for unrestricted shows a deficit but the account is in the green due to sponsorships and vendor payments and dues from members. The budget is very flexible for unrestricted.

Mr. Deramus motioned to approve the financial report as presented. Mr. Ruemke seconded; motion carried.

#### V. Executive Directors Report

- A. There was an EMS Directors Meeting on October 28<sup>th</sup>. The outcome was to go forward with the distribution plan for Senate Bill 8. The application forms are ready and agencies can start submitting requests for students that are going through courses. Reimbursements will not be made until the General Assembly can approve the distribution plan and forms on December 1<sup>st</sup>.
- B. BVRAC needs two members to attend TETAF on December 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Baldree has signed up to attend but we need another voting member to attend. Mr. Rice agreed to attend.

#### VI. Discussion and/or Action Items

- A. Consider for Approval the Opening of Application and Forms Associated with Senate Bill 8 The forms that agencies and individuals need to submit were displayed to include:
  - **1.** Application Packet
  - **2.** Letter of Agreement
  - **3.** Affidavit of Eligibility
  - **4.** Affidavit of Completion

Chairman Rice suggested putting a Senate Bill 8 tab on the website so they can direct students to the forms so they can get it filled out. Courses that started after September 1 will be eligible. The Board needs to approve the forms and opening of this program for our region. The distribution and allocation of funds will be put before the General Assembly on December 1<sup>st</sup> for review and approval.

The distribution plan was displayed. The administrative cost will be reviewed through out the process and any extra funds will be put out to the region. The intent is to get an intern to help with the paperwork and reporting for the contract. The group will need to identify unused funding and get it back in the pool so it can get back in the pool and get expended.

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Mr. Deramus made a motion to approve the opening of the application and forms for Senate Bill 8, subject to the forms needing to be modified in the future as well as the distribution plan. Mr. Ruemke seconded; motion carried.

- B. **Discuss Active Shooter Course** The region did not decide where the course will be held. The provider is about 90 days out as far as scheduling. The Board decided to have the training here. The training may be able to be held at the Brazos Center or the Bush School. Mr. Deramus will send the contract to get the process started. Dates and location will be provided at the next Board Meeting. There will be a small entry fee to help with attendance and allow purchase of refreshments.
- C. **Discuss Pulsara** November 1<sup>st</sup> was the roll out date for the region. BVRAC sent out a message to stop radio communications unless it would be potentially detrimental to the patient. Ms. Christian sent out an email regarding getting radio reports for Code 3 patients. The conversation should happen now to figure out what is happening. Mr. Gonten shared the feedback from the crew is why do we have to do an extra piece of work. Pulsara is not linked into the software and if they have to call the hospital anyway, the Pulsara may fall to the wayside. Ms. Christian shared that Pulsara works great for their noncritical patients, but radio is better for the critical patients. Mr. Rice will be in Houston discussing getting the paid version of Pulsara that would message/call the doctors. Members shared that they had the impression that communication had been happening with the hospitals and that CHI was on board. Members agreed that there needs to be communication between EMS and Hospitals to ensure adequate information is coming through Pulsara (needs to be the same information that would have been given over the radio) and crews cannot be expected to do both radio and Pulsara reports.
- D. **Discuss LiveNet** Mr. Rice sent an email regarding LifeNet and everyone hates it. What does the information for STEMI come through on Pulsara? Can the doctors read the information? Ms. Kopech shared that the EKGs are being shared through Pulsara and the cardiologists are onboard.
- E. **HDE Connect** The region is sporadically connecting ESO records to Meditec. The scanner with the HDE (Health Data Exchange) will help connect. The scanners will be at the hospitals so the numbers can be scanned there. It attaches to anything that has a USB port that will allow USBs. Will help all doctors see medical records for the patients.

#### VII. Committee Reports

- A. **Education** (Ashley Kopech for Jason Giles) The Rural Development Course is scheduled for December 9<sup>th</sup> at BVCOG. BVRAC will provide lunch to the participants. The venue and dates for the next Symposium need to be set soon. Proposed dates and venues will be provided at the next meeting.
- B. **Pre-Hospital** (Kevin Deramus) Covered in Action Items
- C. Hospital Care and Management/ Acute Care (Lacey Krchnak) No report

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- D. **Stroke** (Paula Terrell) Chest Pain Surveyor was very impressed with the RAC involvement so thank you for being there for us! The only issue identified was EMS records. They will be back in the next month or so to ensure there is a process and plan for the EMS records. Mr. Rice asked for information on the agencies that need reports.
- E. System QI/Physician's Advisory (Dr. Ohaju) No report
- F. **Injury Prevention** (Ashley Johse) Stop the Bleed Training was provided to 65 teachers in Bremond ISD for the Elementary, Middle and High Schools. No additional trainings are scheduled at this time
- G. **Disaster/Emergency Preparedness Committee** (Bryan Ruemke) The potential planner for CATRAC turned down the job. CATRAC is still looking for a planner.
- H. **Perinatal** (Dr. Brading) No report

#### VIII. Open Forum

Professor Van with the College of Nursing shared that the school of nursing has funding for a Mobile RV to provide care at rural school districts around the region. Conditions were written in the application that the RV can be used in disasters to provide vaccinations or other information. Board Members asked Professor Van to present at the December 1, 2022 meeting.

Mr. Baldree asked if Board Members want to provide lunch to the General Assembly at the December meeting. The members present agreed to do lunch.
