- **I.** Call to Order The meeting was called to order at 10:00 A.M. by Vice Chair Kopech.
- **II. Introductions** All members introduced themselves.
- III. Approval of December 1, 2022 Meeting Minutes Members present reviewed the minutes. Mr. Deramus motioned to approve the December 1, 2022 meeting minutes. Ms. Parks seconded; motion carried.
- **IV. Financial Report** Mr. Baldree directed the board's attention to page 5 in the board packet for the financial report. The administrative costs are updated through November 30th and the purchases are up to date. Several agencies have submitted requests for EMS County funds and have been reimbursed. Please review the chart and make sure your information is correct and you have received payment if requested. There are five students that have been approved (4 for CHI and 1 for Robertson County) for payment with the Senate Bill 8 funds.

The board will need to consider a budget adjustment in unrestricted once all dues have come in.

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Mr. Deramus motioned to approve the financial report as presented. Ms. Johse seconded; motion carried.

V. Executive Directors Report

- A. Senate Bill 8 BVRAC is set to sign an MOU with Blinn which will make the process much smoother. There have been several conversations regarding self-hosted EMT courses. The funds are eligible for any EMT course that is accredited in the state. The scholarship money is for students, not for agencies. Each student will have to submit an application. The agency must be able to show that their budget was not changed based on the SB8 funds.
- **B.** Symposium and Active Shooter Course The Brazos Center has waived the fees in the past for courses for first responders. This needs to be verified in regards to the Active Shooter Course. The quote for the two-day Symposium on September 6th and 7th is \$2,200. The Active Shooter Course will be May 2nd and 3rd. This will need to be booked soon to ensure these dates are formally booked. The cost for the Active Shooter Course is \$9,000 which will close out the carryover funds from last year.

C. Purchase Updates

- 1. Wristbands The wristbands have been received and CHI St. Joseph and College Station Fire have already picked up their wristbands. Washington County EMS will be picking some up today. There will be a small stockpile kept back at BVCOG offices to help supplement any agency that may run out of wristbands before another order is placed.
- **2.** Needs Assessment The current status with addressing needs and purchases on the needs assessment is:
 - a. Training Courses
 - The Rural Trauma Couse was held last month.
 - Active Shooter is being scheduled.
 - Pinnacle has been discussed.
 - The Board can look at hosting a HazMat Training for Healthcare later in the year.

b. Equipment

- Purchased Training Mannequins have been purchased and some are being held at College Station Fire and some are in the BVCOG offices and are available for any training needs.
- The rest of the purchases are up for discussion throughout the year including McGraths for TAMU EMS, Hazmat/Decon and other supplies for Grimes CHI St. Joseph, Active Shooter Kits, and Fetal Monitors

The Active Shooter Kits are intended to help a truck be able to support a mass casualty event and additional trucks/kits can add to the ability to respond. The quote is roughly \$500/kit. May want to wait until after the Active Shooter course to purchase.

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Ms. Parks asked if BVRAC paid for someone to travel to Pinnacle and do a presentation. It would be good if this person could present their paper at the symposium.

3. BVRAC received a trailer registration form. After review of files and documents it was determined that the trailer was registered under Scott & White. The trailer has been transferred to College Station Fire. The paperwork will be forwarded to College Station.

VI. Discussion and/or Action Items

- A. Consider for approval granting Mr. Baldree authority to sign contracts for Active Shooter Course and Symposium Mr. Deramus made a motion to grant Mr. Baldree authority to sign contracts for the Active Shooter Course and Symposium. Ms. Parks seconded; motion carried.
- **B.** Consider for approval support of Washington County Volunteer Fire Department request with 3 MMUs Mr. Ruemke shared that a Washington County Volunteer Fire Department is planning to host a Wildland Fire Training Course. The MMUs would be set up close to the field practice area to act as a classroom for the participants. They could do their classroom activities inside and be able to step out and do their actual practice. Washington County OEM would support this effort and provide one of the MMUs. The goal is to do the training sometime between March and May. It will be the responsibility for each entity that brings an MMU to have a person that brings the MMU and supervises set up and take down. The MMUs have not been set up as a group for a while so it may be a good opportunity to get the tents set up and inventory done. This item was tabled until February to allow information to be sent to Mr. Baldree regarding the specifics and dates.
- C. Discuss FY23 RAC Data Collaborative Invoice The Board has discussed and agreed to support the RAC Data Collaborative during several previous meetings. The question is where should this expense be categorized going forward. Should this invoice be paid out of the contract budget or unrestricted. Ms. Parks stated that the data being collected is hospital and stroke related. The budget amendment to add the RAC Data Collaborative expense into the EMS RAC Stroke line item will be put up for approval at the next meeting.
- D. Discuss Injury Prevention Fall Prevention Education The Injury Prevention and Education Chairs met and discussed other services and courses that could be offered outside of Stop the Bleed since there are many community partners offering Stop the Bleed Courses in the area. They will still provide STB courses when requested but will not be seeking any out. Efforts are going to be focused on another population. Falls are the number one mechanism of injury in the region. The idea discussed is to go out to the Assisted Living Centers and providing a 30-minute training and packet of information on Fall Prevention. They would also play a game like Bingo with prizes being non-slip socks and other related materials. BVCOG has an Ombudsmen Program and Meals on Wheels that would be good resource for contacts and getting information out to home-bound individuals. Mr. Deramus would like to take care of the Brenham area.

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- E. Discuss Pulsara This has been a standing topic in the EMS Chiefs Meeting for the last six or seven months. Several Hospital representatives have showed up to these meetings and have provided input to the Chiefs to standardize the reports. The information was taken back to the departments and implemented the items that made sense. There was a Pulsara outage, and it does need to be discussed what happens when we do have to revert to radio/phone call contacts. Mr. Deramus would like to provide minutes for the workgroups to the General Assembly group. Ms. Kopech asked if there has been any feedback from the hospitals once the changes were made. Brenham has provided feedback from the Brenham Nurses in some cases. Ms. Kopech expressed that hospitals should be providing that feedback since it is the only way the system will get better. Ms. Johse shared that Ms. Christian talked with Bryan Fire and other agencies and asked that the facility be radioed or called with Code 3 patients. This seems to be working.
- **F.** Discussion of Senate Bill 8 Requests and Activities BVRAC has not received as many as anticipated for these funds. The information will be sent out again to confirm that everyone has submitted their forms.

- **G. Disaster/Emergency Preparedness Committee** (Bryan Ruemke) There was a meeting last week with CATRAC. There will be quarterly HCC Chair meetings so the RACs can stay on the same page. There will be one standard plan and each region will have an annex with the specifics for that area. They are working on burn and pediatric exercises and are looking at having an EMTF component to those. The EMTF for this region is not deployable and needs repairs. This will be a funding priority for CATRAC HPP funds. Will be trying to get water quick connect information for hospitals together.

VIII. Open Forum

Purchasing Solutions here at BVCOG has communications with OnMed. It is a portable Telemed option that could be set up in areas for the region. It is basically a doc in a box. They can prescribe and give medications. Could be a good option for jail systems to reduce travel expenses.

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Amber Heredia is the new Trauma Coordinator for the CHI College Station Hospital. Ms. Porter is moving to a management position at CHI Bryan but will be staying on with BVRAC Board.
