- **II. Introductions** All members introduced themselves.
- III. Approval of January 13, 2023 Meeting Minutes Members present reviewed the minutes. Mr. Giles motioned to approve the January 13, 2023 meeting minutes. Mr. Ruemke seconded; motion carried.

Senate Bill 8 payments, EMS RAC Carryover and Administrative costs to the current EMS RAC and Systems Development budget. The EMS RAC Carryover funds will be fully expended with the Active Shooter Course payment.

Mr. Ruemke motioned to approve the financial report as presented. Mr. Giles seconded; motion carried.

## V. Executive Directors Report –

- A. <u>Senate Bill 8</u> If any agency has questions on the process, please do not hesitate to reach out. At the last Pre-Hospital Meeting several agencies had questions that have lined up with questions asked around the state. If any agencies have questions on self-hosting EMT courses, please reach out and join a call with the state.
- B. <u>Active Shooter Course</u> Course is set for May 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>. Mr. Rice will follow up on getting the fees waived at the Brazos Center. An Eventbrite link will be shared along with flyers and other information to promote the event.
- C. <u>Symposium 2023</u> Symposium is set for September 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> at the Brazos Center. Ms. Parks will be leading a discussion at noon today on what the symposium will look like and what activities need to be started.
- D. <u>Update on purchases</u>
  - 1. Jewett and Hilltop Lakes have wristbands available if they need them.
  - **2.** Need to reassess needs assessment based on where the budget is after the McGrath and Active Shooter kit purchases.
  - **3.** The Washington VFD request to use the MMUs is still tabled. The details have not been ironed out for the training.
  - **4.** Will plan to attend GETAC in the beginning of March.
  - 5. There is an outstanding trailer registration for license # 49064A. The trailer may be with College Station Fire Department and if so, the trailer has been registered by the city. A workgroup should be developed to look at the trailers and what is in them.

#### VI. Discussion and/or Action Items

- A. Consider for approval purchase of McGrath Laryngoscopes for EMS Agencies Last year, the RAC purchased 5 laryngoscopes for a total of \$8,500. The request this year is from TAMU EMS. The question is how many are needed. TAMU EMS has two trucks in service and one in reserve. Need to loop Pre-Hospital into the decision on number that are needed. This action item is tabled to allow the Pre-Hospital group to discuss and bring it to the next meeting.
- B. Consider for approval purchase of Active Shooter Kits for EMS Agencies These kits were discussed at the last Board meeting. These are self-contained kits to respond to an active shooter event that would be put on ambulances. This item was tabled to allow Pre-Hospital to discuss and bring it to the next meeting.
- C. **Discuss FY23 Budget Adjustment RAC Data Collaborative Invoice –** The total amount of the invoice is \$1,746.71 and the proposed change is to move the funds from the Education line item in EMS RAC and put it on the Stroke/Cardiac line item. The

RAC Data Collaborative helps drive the stroke and cardiac education for the region, especially for the Level IV entities that are not with Get with the Guidelines. Ms. Kopech made a motion to approve moving funds from Education to Stroke and Cardiac to pay the RAC Data Collaborative Invoice. Ms. Porter seconded; motion carried.

D. **Discuss Pulsara** – Ms. Kopech asked for input from ER Staff, and they have shared that they were not getting enough information but it is improving. The staff have been encouraged to have some patience with Bryan Fire since they just went live. Overall, it has been good feedback. The paramedics should be trusted. The main concern is to not miss the really bad ones and adding a large checklist to what they need to do will not be a help and will not be done.

On March 1<sup>st</sup>, CHI will start with a paid trial with Trauma & Cardiac. Teams will be built in CHI Regional and College Station. Internal processes will not change but Pulsara Screen will change. The hospitals will need to figure out who should be on the teams. Cardiac is very excited to be on it.

E. **Discuss Senate Bill 8** – The concern is that the region will not spend all the money. There have not been as many requests as expected. Local agencies have shared concerns about what happens if a student does not complete the requirements and the advice from the group and the state is that the burden falls on the student and not the agency. The original intent was to get paramedics on ambulances and some of the requirements may be loosened as time goes on. Need to encourage rural agencies, like Hilltop Lakes, to utilize these funds.

May need to make a formal change to the allotment but the RAC will continue to track the progress.

Ms. Krchnak has accepted a position as Nurse Practitioner at St Joseph and will be stepping down from her position as Hospital / Acute Care Chair.
