- **I.** Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 1:03 P.M. by Chairman Rice.
- **II. Introductions:** General Assembly conducted self-introductions.
- III. Presentation- Update on CHI Bryan from Beverly Welch Ms. Welch shared the anticipated changes at CHI Bryan that will move the facility from a Level II to a Level III facility. There are a few things that still must be done but the anticipated official change in level will occur May 1st. The changes that involve patient care are:
 - Operating Room Availability OR will be covered from 7:00 am 11:00 pm. Then staff will be on call and able to respond within 30 minutes. Will need the earliest notification possible from EMS in the field.
 - Anesthesia Services Anesthesia services will be part of the OR activation and have the same hours as OR staff.

Staff reviewed hospital data and most trauma patients (99%) come to the ER between the hours of 7:00 am – 11:00 pm so the changes will not affect the majority of patients. These changes allow surgeons and anesthesiologists to stay with family instead of sleeping in the hospital. There will be an official notification to the RAC once this change has been formally made.

- IV. Approval of February 1, 2024 Minutes: Members present reviewed the minutes from February 1, 2024. Mr. Giles motioned to approve the February 1, 2024 minutes. Mr. Deramus seconded; motion carried.
- V. Financial Report: An adjustment to the EMS RAC budget was approved by the BVRAC Board this morning. The adjustment shifted the budget amounts with Education and Acute Care to address the overages. The other areas of the budget have been updated to reflect the current charges and expenditures.

Ms. Johse made a motion to accept the financials as presented. Ms. Condrey seconded; motion carried.

anticipated course date. Spots will be distributed to all agencies. Ms. Johse made a motion to approve paying \$9,000 towards the FTEP course. Ms. Mendoza seconded; motion carried.

- **B.** Discussion and possible action regarding Senate Bill 8 Allocations March 31st is the final date to submit name and application to utilize allocation. Funds will be available to any agency on April 1st.
- **C. Discussion of RAC Performance Criteria and Self-Assessment** Discussion needs to be continued with this. This is not due for some time but BVRAC will turn the assessment in early in the process.

VIII. Committee Reports

- A. Disaster/Emergency Preparedness (Bryan Ruemke): There was a lengthy discussion on finances at the HPP meeting today. Some steps were also identified that the region and CATRAC should take moving forward in this discussion. Chairman Rice stated that a letter should be written to the CATRAC Board that lists the bullet points from the meeting. Important dates for providers in the region include:
 - 1. Chili fest April 5th and 6th
 - 2. Solar Eclipse April 8th
 - 3. MS 150 April 28th
 - 4. MRSE Exercise April 26th
- **B. Education (Adam Gallagher):** The FTEP course will be scheduled for late June. AirMed 12 symposium is May 21st and registration is open. Stop the Bleed training will be provided to Anderson ISD. One or two more instructors would not hurt if anyone is available.
- C. Pre-Hospital (Kevin Deramus): EMS group meets once a month outside of this meeting. The group discusses Pulsara issues and Senate Bill 8 funding as well as adjustments to the needs assessment for agencies in the region.

Chairperson Rice shared that the ESO/Pulsara integration was turned on for CHI EMS. This is very early in ESO's integration so there will be some changes and learning curves.

- D. Hospital Care and Management/ Acute Care (Lori Porter): No Report.
- **E. Stroke (Amy Plotts):** The spreadsheet for the VAN scores was displayed. There were some questions on data provided in the spreadsheet that will be taken to Ms. Plotts.
- **F.** System QI/Physician's Advisory (Wanda Dias): Need a stubborn physician leader that wants to drive Systems QI. Ms. Parks said that there should be two people. There need to be quarterly meetings set up.
- **G. Injury Prevention** (**Brandi Mendoza**): Ms. Mendoza attended a CarFit training course that would be a good service to provide to the region. If there is a Community Health Fair at BVCOG this year, that would be a good time to offer this service since the community will already be here and the parking lot can be used for the fittings. This is a service for mature adults to ensure their car is set up in the best way for safe driving.

Expenditure Deadline for Amendment 1 Funds

To All Hospitals and EMS Agencies in TSA-N:

Subject: Deadline for Expenditure of Amendment 1 Funds

All hospitals and EMS agencies within TSA-N are hereby notified that they have until July 1, 2024, to expend all remaining allocations of Amendment 1 Funds. The purpose of this deadline is to ensure the comprehensive utilization of these funds within our region, thereby maximizing their impact on our healthcare infrastructure and services.

It is imperative that all Amendment 1 Funds allocated to your respective institutions be utilized fully by the specified deadline. Failure to expend these funds may result in their return to the Department of State Health Services (DSHS), which would hinder our ability to address critical healthcare needs within TSA-N.

In the event that any funds remain unspent by July 1, 2024, the Brazos Valley Regional Advisory Council (BVRAC) will intervene to ensure their utilization towards a "Regional Project." This project will be determined based on the identified needs by BVRAC's General Assembly and approved by the BVRAC Board of Directors during the July Board of Directors Meeting. The aim is to allocate these resources efficiently and effectively, aligning with the priorities and objectives outlined by our healthcare community.

We urge all hospitals and EMS agencies to expedite the expenditure of their remaining Amendment 1 Funds to ensure compliance with this policy and to maximize the benefit to our region's healthcare system.

Senate Bill 8 Update

Adam Gallagher will send an updated chart of Senate Bill 8 requests. Mr. Heritage will get the final amount that will be moved over from the administration line item.

ESO / Pulsara Integration

Eric Leland shared that demographic, vitals and any attachments come over. The armband does not. It is helpful with large events and when using multiple units to respond. Cost is under \$350/year for smaller agencies – the cost may be tied to how many calls you have a year so larger agencies may have a larger cost.

Mass Incidents in Pulsara

The agencies are good at setting up events like football games and other preplanned events. The group needs to work on setting up these during the immediate events (like the DPS event). Washington County practiced this at a staff meeting and where they stumbled was adding in state resources. Mr. Leland suggested adding them as an agency. The board members discussed stopping the communication drills with radios and using Pulsara instead. Robertson County will work with non-clinical staff to set up incidents in Pulsara. Washington County agreed that they were looking at other staff for this purpose. May want to develop a non-clinical training of sorts for the region. Need to start doing it for all incidents so everyone can get used to doing it.

Training with ER Staff – Handing Off Patients

Need to do a proper handing off and closing of patients for transfers/hand offs. ER staff need to be on the same page for doing this. Need to reach out to the Hospital Care and Management Committee to help get a training set up.
