- I. **Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 1:00 P.M. by Chairperson Parks.
- II. **Introductions:** General Assembly conducted self-introductions
- III. **Approval of General Assembly’s October 2, 2025 Meeting Minutes:** Members present reviewed the minutes sent out in the packet and displayed at the meeting. Ms. Johse motioned to approve the minutes. Ms. Heredia seconded; motion carried.
- IV. **Financial Report:** Mr. Heritage directed the members’ attention to page 8 of the packet for the financial report. Updates include:
- EMS RAC is almost 100% administrative except for the \$3,000 set aside for wristbands. There is 88% of this fund remaining. It should be closer to 75% since December is the fourth month of the fiscal year.
 - RAC Systems Development has 82% remaining. These funds are allocated to different committees and travel expenses. Recent expenses include reimbursement for GETAC travel and \$4,500 deposit for the FTEP course.
 - There is an action item today for the Amendment 3 budget. One of the hospitals accidentally left off of the last budget. The amounts allocated to the facilities have changed a little, but most are seeing an increase from last year.
 - EMS County are available to eligible EMS agencies as determined by the state and RAC participation. No requests have been submitted yet for these funds. These funds must be used by August 31, 2026.
 - A new chart has been added to the unrestricted fund budget to include the revenue coming into the budget. This includes the membership dues and any funds remaining from what was taken in for the symposium after the expenses are covered. There is \$66,193.04 in the unrestricted budget.
- Ms. Guerra made a motion to accept the financial report as presented. Ms. Mendoza seconded; motion carried.
- V. **Executive Director’s Report** –Mr. Heritage thanked everyone for their help with the symposium. There were 80 participants who gave a lot of feedback. The hope is to continue to make the event bigger and better each year. Other updates include:
- Reminder that BVRAC dues are due in January.
 - The BVRAC Board of Directors approved partnering with SETRAC and a MOU has been signed. Work cannot begin until the contract is given out by the state and signed by the RACs. BVRAC was allocated just shy of \$600,000 to get equipment, supplies and blood products needed to support EMS agencies. The plan is to have a blood bank refrigerator located in a central location where EMS

agencies can get more blood or trade in blood that is getting ready to expire so hospitals and other locations can use it.

VI. Discussion and/or Action Items

- A. Consider for Approval authorizing the Executive Director to make expenditures in excess of \$10,000, as necessary for prehospital whole blood program equipment and supplies** - The expectation is that the state will send the contracts out and expect the RACs to get started right away to get the program started. Ms. Guerra made a motion to authorize the Executive Director to make expenditures in excess of \$10,000 as necessary for prehospital whole blood program equipment and supplies. Mr. McLemore seconded; motion carried.
- B. Consider for approval the FY2026 Amendment 3/EI Funds Budget** – Management funds decreased from \$10,000 to \$5,000 this year. These funds can roll over into the next fiscal year. Mr. Gallagher made a motion to approve the FY2026 Amendment 3/EI Funds budget. Ms. Johse seconded; motion carried.
- C. Discussion of Prehospital Whole Blood Program Updates** – The whole blood task force is getting close to finalizing the process. The state is wanting to know which patients got blood that needed blood, that got blood but did not need it and if a patient did not get blood that needed blood. The main question is was the patient in hemorrhagic shock. The group will need to look at what information and data to track. STRAC may be willing to release their tracking software so the other regions can use it.
- D. Discussion of RAC Symposium** – Chairperson Parks thanked TEEX for allowing the RAC to come out and have the symposium. Topics discussed during the board meeting for the next symposium included burns, MCI, snake bites and more skills stations.

VII. Committee Reports

- A. Disaster/Emergency Preparedness (Herman Iles / Kristen Christian):** Topics discussed at the meeting today include:
- EMResource gave an update on Bed Sync that will automatically update bed availability every 15 minutes in EMResource. This program is paid for by the state. There will be an email in the minutes that you can contact to get additional information.
 - MERCI exercise is April 15th. Controller workgroup on December 12th
- B. Education (Adam Gallagher):** FTEP course is coming up in January. There are not a lot of EMS agencies signed up right now. December 20th is the deadline to sign up and get your spot. After that, the spots will be opened up to agencies outside the region. The NRP courses are also coming up, and the books will be ordered for participants to use.

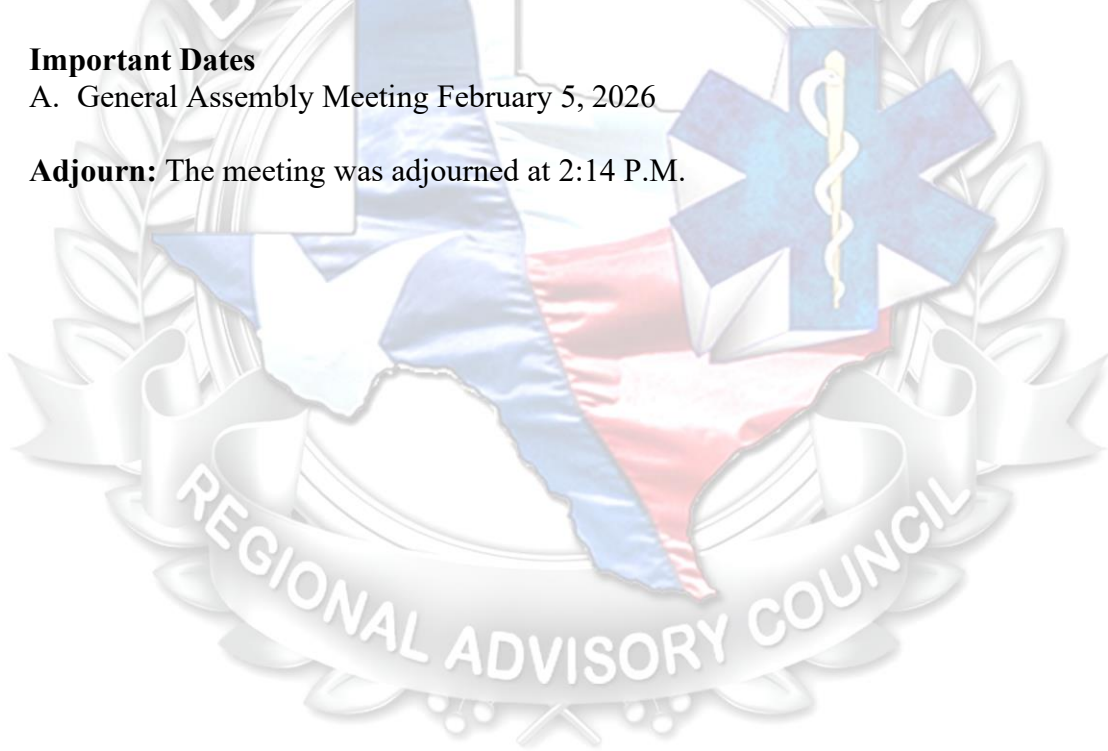
- C. **Pre-Hospital (Adam Gallagher for Kevin Deramus):** The state says that we are at 1.57% as far as wristband usage. Local agencies see usage much higher. The issue is probably with where the data is pulled from the EMS software to put into the state software/spreadsheet.
- D. **Trauma /Special Populations (Courtney Saunders):** Met with St. Joseph Trauma Program Manager to make sure we are collecting the same data and put together a spreadsheet. The state spreadsheet will be reviewed as well to make sure we are collecting all of the same information. Baylor Scott and White facilities will be sent an excel sheet to fill out. The St. Joseph facilities will use a google form. The big push is to not delay transfers. The region will start with penetrating trauma transfers since it is a smaller number than blunt force trauma.
- E. **Stroke / Cardiac (Amy Plotts):** The region is close to getting caught up on VAN data. The critical access hospitals are now set up with Get With the Guidelines. There are no patients listed currently for the region. Ms. Plotts will get with the hospitals to make sure they are put in. GETAC is focusing on Pediatric Stroke. The region needs to look at what hospitals will take pediatric strokes. AirMed has seen an uptick in pediatric stroke cases. Chairperson Parks suggested doing a case review on this. Mr. Gallagher suggested everyone participate in the Pediatric Readiness Training that is available. The link is available on the RAC website. If you sign up, you get reminders about the training available.
- F. **System QI/Physician's Advisory (Dr. Nicholas Nunnally / Amber Heredia):** The data was displayed for January through November 2025. The top two reasons for transfer were orthopedics and pediatrics. The top three receiving hospitals were Texas Children's, Baylor Scott & White Temple and Memorial Hermann. The majority of patients were 65 and over but followed closely by 18-64. The reason for delay was recently added, and it is about half and half between facility acceptance and transportation. The majority of the facility acceptance issues are with medicine, and the transportation issues are with trauma. There is a big push to send films in advance to receiving facilities to help with some of the delays and sending a patient who may not need to go. Mr. Gallagher asked if Pulsara could help with this as well with the video consult. Will need to follow up and have discussions with receiving facilities.
- G. **Injury Prevention (Riley Fisher/Christina Nickerson):** In October there was a CarFit event. This was the first public event, and it did really well. Also in October, about 500 Airforce Corp of Cadets members were trained in Stop the Bleed. In the last Texas Stop the Bleed Coalition Meeting, BVRAC got recognition for doing the most stop the bleed classes and having the most participants in Texas.
- Chairperson Parks pointed out that EMS also got recognition at the meeting for having the highest participation in the Pediatric Readiness Assessment.
- H. **Perinatal (Dr. Katie Brading):** There was not a meeting today. The NRP class is coming up on January 21 and 28. The books will be ordered.

- VIII. Open Forum** – Mr. Varner with College Station pointed out that there is a high increase in auto / pedestrian accidents, especially with the scooters. They are regularly not wearing helmets and cutting in and out of traffic and pedestrian areas. Ms. Fisher mentioned that she has received several requests on this topic over the last four months. TxDot wants to work on it as well to do an Auto / Pedestrian Program. May look at coordinating this with the university as well.

TEEX had the EMS Initial Education Advisory Program Meeting on November 13th and Ms. Montgomery thanked those who participated in the meeting. The program has experienced a large revamp over the last year. The focus is to improve the student's experience and the collaboration with community partners and stakeholders. They recently had a reaccreditation visit that went well but one of the suggestions was to improve collaboration with clinic affiliates to get input from those who are receiving the EMS and Paramedic students. The advisory meetings will be twice a year, and the next one will be in March. The date will be sent out to all RAC members.
